## NEW 2020 AHA GUIDELINES FOR CPR AND ECC

Released in October, the 2020 American Heart
Association Guidelines for CPR and ECC are
based on the most current and comprehensive
review of resuscitation science, systems, protocols,
and education. See key updates below and

#### **RECOVERY ADDED TO**THE CHAIN OF SURVIVAL

Recovery was added as the sixth link in the Chain of Survival. "The process of recovering from cardiac arrest extends long after the initial hospitalization. Support is needed during recovery to ensure optimal physical, cognitive, and emotional well-being and return to social/role functioning."



#### **REAL-TIME CPR**FEEDBACK

The 2020 Guidelines continue to reinforce the importance of real-time CPR feedback and note, "Use of real-time audiovisual feedback is suggested as a means to maintain CPR quality."



#### PHYSIOLOGIC MONITORING OF CPR QUALITY

The 2020 Guidelines have been updated to reflect this: "It may be reasonable to use physiologic parameters such as arterial blood pressure or EtCO<sub>2</sub> when feasible to monitor and optimize CPR quality." 1



#### CLINICAL DEBRIEFING RECOMMENDED

The Guidelines encourage that "... debriefings should be supplemented by discussion of objective, quantitative data such as CPR quality performance data (chest compression rate, depth, and fraction); telemetry and defibrillation tracings; end-tidal CO<sub>2</sub> tracings; and resuscitation records."<sup>2</sup>



### RESUSCITATION EDUCATION IS PARAMOUNT

The Guidelines discuss the importance of resuscitation education and now emphasize it as well. "The use of deliberate practice and mastery learning during life support training, and incorporating repetition with feedback and minimum passing standards, can improve skill acquisition."
